Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to everyone who attended our classroom learning events this week. We hope you enjoyed coming into school and engaging with your children.

Many thanks to everyone who completed the parent and carer survey - we had a total of 120 responses. I will share the outcomes which were really positive alongside some helpful comments and suggestions that we will consider and will report back on. We also undertake staff and pupil surveys to really capture every stakeholder's voice.

All results were up slightly on already good results from last year which has been lovely to read. There are always areas for improvement and one issue raised this year was more advance notice of dates and events which is a valid point. I have shared this with staff and we will ensure we not only map out events much further in advance than we do currently, we will also make you aware of these dates. It has been a busy time for sports events involving our pupils. Some of our Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 girls participated in a football tournament and qualified for the final at Goals in Norwich. We went to the finals and played against the other 11 best school teams in the county – fabulous achievement! Some of our pupils attended a Sports Leaders event at the UEA and will be developing their roles with the support of Mr Leather. Premier Sports ran a lacrosse event for the whole school. The children learnt to throw a bean bag or ball with a lacrosse stick and gained points for how far they could throw. The scores have been collated and then entered against other schools' scores. If we get the most points we win a prize for the school – fingers crossed! We have also had visitors in who ran a martial arts taster session for pupils and Wymondham Rugby Club also ran two taster days for all pupils in KS2.

The installation of our outdoor gym was unfortunately delayed, but we are expecting this to now start on Monday.

You may have seen our photo in the press this week, regarding our involvement with the Sapientia Education Trust. We are still on schedule to join SET on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025.
