Dear Parents and Carers,

Finally, it feels like summer and with the nice weather come all those things that signal that the end of a school year is approaching.

Our teachers are busy report writing and reflecting and celebrating how far the children have come since first joining them back in September! Our school field is busy every afternoon with classes and teams practising for our upcoming sports days. Our Y6 pupils are looking smart in their Y6 leavers hoodies and are busy preparing for all the fun end of primary school activities, including a final assembly for Y6 parents and carers, A trip to Pleasurewood Hills, Prom (thanks to FORPS) and lots more.

At the same time though we still have almost 6 weeks to go and teaching and learning is still in full swing with staff supporting all our pupils to be as prepared as they can be, socially and academically for the next step in their school journey.

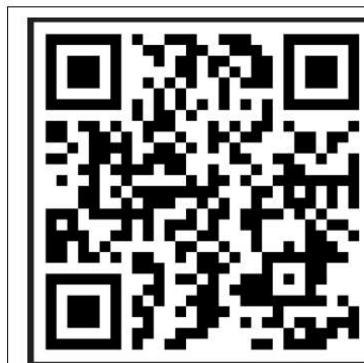
